The recommendation discusses a specific action to be taken that can foster a sense of belonging between one group and another group; reflects on policy, representations, educational curricula, or other evidence to support the reformation of inclusion of the studied community in Oklahoma. The explanation of the recommendation is analytical; thoughtful; and draws upon the connections, inferences, and extensive knowledge about the community in question.
